

Lions Guardianship Program – General Information

Finally members of the Lions Family have an opportunity to make a real difference in the lives of children with type 1 diabetes.

Camp Huronda, owned and operated by the Canadian Diabetes Association is located on the southern shores of Lake Waseosa, just outside of Huntsville, Ontario. Huronda accommodates up to 92 boys and girls, ages 8 to 15 for 4 x two-week sessions and 2 x one-week sessions during July and August. Some 375 children experienced a summer adventure of fun, activities, new skills and health care in 2009 as well as another 55 individuals in the 4-day Family Camp Program. Unfortunately 57 children had to be turned away due to space limitations.

Camp Huronda operations are dependent upon the support of foundations, service clubs, corporate and private donations. The Lions Guardianship Program was conceived to raise much needed funds towards the camp's ongoing maintenance requirement of about \$50,000.00 annually. Donations will allow children with type 1 (insulin dependent) diabetes enjoy a residential camping experience while learning to manage their diabetes in a fun and rewarding atmosphere. The Camp Huronda camping program is designed to provide an educational opportunity for children to learn life long diabetes management skills. With the support of highly qualified medical professionals, exceptional camp counsellors and these donations, the Camp is able to achieve these objectives.

The Lions Family of District A-12 has developed the "Guardian of Camp Huronda" project in order to raise much needed funds to help the refurbishment and capital projects for the camp. 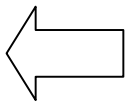
